Art Scholarship for Lakota High School Students

The Art Council of West Chester and Liberty (ACWCL) is pleased to announce an Art Education Scholarship for students enrolled in Lakota East and Lakota West High Schools who plan to major in Art in the amount of \$250 for a student from each school. This scholarship is intended for students who have a passion for Art. Following are the criteria and eligibility guidelines for the ACWCL Art Scholarship to be awarded during the Senior Award Ceremonies of both schools.

Art forms that will be considered:

Visual Art and Photography

Eligibility Criteria:

The following eligibility criteria must be met in order to apply for the ACWCL Scholarship for Lakota East/West Students:

- Must be a senior during the 2014-15 academic year.
- Student must have at least a 2.50 GPA.
- Student must provide a digital portfolio of five to ten images of their work. It should be emailed to artscouncilwcl@gmail.com by midnight April 24, 2015. Digital images need to be in JPG format. Name each JPG with your name and number as it appears on image list (example: MSmith_1.jpg, MSmith_2.jpg). The submission should include an image list that includes image number, the year created, the title, the medium and the dimensions (H x W x D).
- Student should submit two references from anyone who can provide an assessment of their artistic skills and abilities.
- Student must plan to attend college or technical school the semester following his or her high school graduation; additionally students must plan to focus or major in an Art program.
- In order to demonstrate his/her commitment, all finalists will provide a written statement of how they plan to support the field of art in the future.
- Student should provide an artist's statement that gives detail about their process and art.
- All lists and statements should be in PDF format or a Word document.

Application Period:

Students may apply for the scholarship from March 23 through April 24, 2015.
